

**Clark County Fire District 6

Part-time Maintenance Worker

**Opens: February 7, 2017
Closes: February 21, 2017**

Hourly Rate of Wage: \$14.00 - \$16.00

PURPOSE

To create a list of individuals for an eligibility roster for the position of Part-time Maintenance Worker. This is a second part-time position that has been approved for immediate hire.

DUTIES

The Part-time Maintenance Worker, as directed and supervised by the Equipment & Facility Maintenance Specialist will be primarily responsible for fire hydrant maintenance along with occasional grounds and facility duties.

The Part-time Maintenance Worker will work a flexible schedule throughout the year; will not exceed 69 hours per calendar month more than four times in a single year. Hours shall be approved by the Equipment & Facility Maintenance Specialist. Work is to be performed at all Fire District 6 facilities and some offsite locations.

Duties (to include, but not limited to):

Primary

- Fire hydrant maintenance (flowing, painting, static pressure testing and road marker placement) and record keeping.

Secondary

- General maintenance, cleaning of facilities and grounds.
- Mowing, edging, weeding, pruning and fertilizing grounds.

WORK HOURS

Hours of work may be flexible as determined by the Equipment & Facility Maintenance Specialist, however will fall between Monday and Friday.

UNIFORM AND PROTECTIVE CLOTHING

The Fire District provides T-Shirts, Sweat Shirts and Polo Shirts along with any required protective clothing for use by employee.

TO QUALIFY

- Be 21 years of age at application delivery.
- Have a high school diploma or GED.
- Be in good physical condition.
- Not have had any felony convictions within the past 7 years.
- Some misdemeanors and juvenile convictions may be disqualifiers. Include descriptions with your

application.

- Have a valid driver's license.
- Have no record of driver's license suspension or revocation in any state within the last three (3) years.

HIRING PROCEDURE

Completion and provision of Fire District 6 application form. Top 3 candidates per review of applications will be interviewed by Equipment & Facility Maintenance Specialist, to determine offer of employment. Medical evaluation and Background check if applicable will be conducted at Fire District's expense.
