EMS Levy Renewal Speakers Bureau

Fire District 6 is pleased to offer an opportunity to local community groups to learn more about the District, its funding, and the EMS levy renewal which will be on the August primary ballot. Fire Chief Jerry Green and other Chief Officers are available to give a 25-minute PowerPoint presentation with a question and answer session to follow.

The EMS Levy was first passed by voters in 1981. It supports Advanced Life Support (ALS)/paramedic care. ALS is vital, life-sustaining pre-hospital care that can only be administered by a certified paramedic. The current EMS levy expires at the end of this year. If it is not renewed, Fire District 6 will no longer be able to provide ALS/paramedic care, and response times will increase as a result of layoffs.

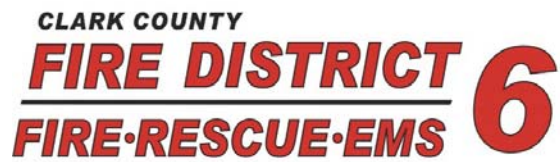
