### 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter Emergency Responses

Clark County Fire District 6 responded to more emergencies during the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2010 compared to 2009. The total number of emergencies increased slightly from 1,203 in 2009 to 1,215 in 2010. While fire calls were down during this year's first quarter calls for emergency medical service (EMS) were up by 18 over last year.

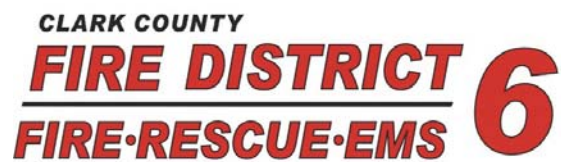
Fire District 6 continues to exceed its objective to arrive at the scene of an emergency in 6 minutes or less 90 percent of the time. In fact, crews arrived in 6 minutes or less 91.8 percent of the time during the first quarter of 2010. The first quarter average response time was 3 minutes, 40 seconds.
