Board Appoints new Fire Commissioner

Clark County Fire District 6 Commissioners appoint Brad Lothspeich to fill the seat vacated by Dick Spring. The term of the appointment is until the General Election, at which time the person elected will fill not only the remainder of Spring's term, which expires at the end of 2011, but a full six-year term. Commissioner Lothspeich was sworn in during last night's Board meeting.

"The fire service and community involvement have always been important to me" said Lothspeich, "and this opportunity lets me be further involved in both," he continued.

Commissioner Lothspeich was a District 6 Fire Chief from 1994-2003; Assistant Fire Chief from 1991-1994. From 1974-1991 he served as a firefighter, Lieutenant, Captain, and Battalion Chief. Lothspeich retired in 2003 and now works as a broker/realtor for Prudential Northwest Properties and volunteers with a number of community groups in a variety of capacities: a Board Director for the Hazel Dell/Salmon Creek Business Association and co-chairman of the Parade of Bands; Vice Chairman of the Three Creeks Community Partners; on the Supervisory Committee with IQ Credit Union; and a member of the Felida Neighborhood Association.

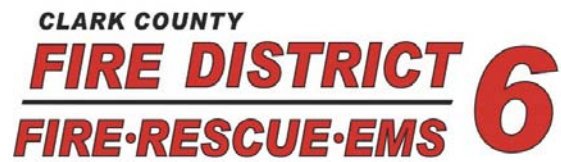
Commissioner Lothspeich holds a bachelors degree in Business Administration/Personnel Management from Eastern Washington University.
