

**CLARK COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT NO. 6  
RESOLUTION NO. 2009-06**

**OPTING OUT OF COMMUNITY REVITALIZATION FINANCING**

**BACKGROUND**

1. The District has received a Notice of Public Hearing from Clark County pursuant to Chapter 270, Laws of 2009 “the Act.”
2. The Notice provides that Clark County intends to adopt a Resolution approving the 179<sup>th</sup> Street Revitalization Area under the Act which includes property located within the District.;
3. The Act should not affect the tax revenues collected by the District because the District is not defined as a “local government” or as a “participating taxing district” under the Act;
4. Despite the exclusion of fire protection districts from the definition of participating taxing district, Section 106 of the Act provides that “taxing districts” (which includes fire protection districts) may by Resolution formally remove itself as a participating taxing district to prohibit use of its property tax revenues for the local revitalization financing of public improvements in a revitalization area; and.
5. The District has determined that it does not want to allow the use of any of its property tax revenues for the local revitalization financing of public improvements in the 179<sup>th</sup> Street Revitalization Area.

**RESOLUTION**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Clark County Fire Protection District No. 6:

1. Hereby prohibit the use of any of the District’s property tax revenues for the local revitalization financing of public improvements in the 179<sup>th</sup> Street Revitalization Area;
2. To avoid any confusion under the Act, the District hereby removes itself as a participating taxing district in the 179<sup>th</sup> Street Revitalization Area as required by Section 106 of the Act.

3. District staff shall cause a copy of this Resolution to be delivered to Clark County, the Sponsoring Agency, at the following address:


4. Such delivery shall constitute notice to the sponsoring local government in the manner required by Section 106 of the Act.


